What: Flood Damaged Tree Farms

Where: Boistfort Valley

There has been lots of newspaper coverage of the December flood damage to people's homes and farmer's fields, but nothing on the effects of the flood on people's tree farms. We will visit two tree farms that suffered flood and mud damage in different aged stands and different species.

Parking is limited, so please join a carpool at the Exit 77 Park and Ride. The Twilight Tour begins at 6:30 at the Charles Coddington's tree farm.

Driving Directions for those who drive: Go 8.8 miles west of I-5 on Highway 6. Just past the bridge, turn left on Boistfort Road. Continue 6.0 miles, past the Boistfort School and Baw Faw Grange and Fire Station. At the Boistfort store, Boistfort Road becomes Wildwood Road, on which you will continue another 3.6 miles. On the left is the driveway to 1822 Wildwood Road and on the right is a green gate. Go through the gate and over the bridge, down the lane, through another gate and down the lane to parking.

When we leave the Coddington's, turn right onto the Wildwood Road, drive 0.8 miles to the Jones Road, turn right, cross the bridge and drive to the end of the road for parking.
