Coming Soon! “Ties to the Land” Workshop in Chehalis

“Ties to the Land: Succession planning for family forest landowners” is a facilitated workshop to help guide family forest owners through a smooth transition of their land from one generation to the next. The workshop explores the human side of estate planning and focuses on ways to maintain family ties to the land from generation to generation, building awareness of key challenges facing family businesses and motivating families to address those challenges. Ties to the Land workshops consist of a mix of presentations and practical exercises to help families develop techniques needed to address tough issues.

Sessions are being offered throughout the state in November and December. The closest one will be in Chehalis on **Friday, December 5<sup>th</sup>, 6:30 – 8:30 p.m. and Friday December 12<sup>th</sup>, 6:30 – 8:30 p.m. at the Veterans Memorial Museum**, 100 SW Veterans Way, Chehalis. Take Exit 77 off I-5, go west of the freeway 150 feet and turn left (south) on Riverside. Go 1/3 mile to Veterans Way and turn left (east) to the Museum.
