What: Tour of Cascade Hardwoods Mill

When: Tuesday, September 19, 2006 6:30 p.m.

Where: 158 Ribelin Road, Chehalis

Our tour of this extensively remodeled mill will showcase their newly paved log yard, as well as the modern processing facilities. Come find out what happens to those valuable alder logs you sell.

The mill will be in operation during our visit. It is important to wear sturdy shoes, preferably boots, rather than tennis shoes and definitely NOT sandals or any open shoes. If you have a hard hat, bring it, and earplugs are always helpful during mill tours.

From I-5 and Chehalis: Take Exit 77 off I-5, and turn east into Chehalis, continuing straight on Main until you reach Market Street. Take Market Street south apx. 2-1/2 miles until you reach Ribelin Road. Turn right on Ribelin and continue to the mill. Watch for green Forestry Tour signs.

From the south, take Jackson Highway apx. 6 miles north of Mary's Corner to Ribelin Road. Turn left on to Ribelin and continue to the mill. Watch for green Forestry Tour signs.
