**WHAT:** Twilite Tour at a logging show near Kingston which will highlight the use of a LogMax harvesting head, owned and operated by WFFA Life Member Gene Anest. Paul Nyman the technical representative for LogMax will describe the intricacies of this computerized state of the art equipment. This equipment as the name implies, optimizes and maximizes timber harvest results, while reducing time and impact. The LogMax can dramatically enhance the return on your next harvest and it is very worth while for forest land owners to have knowledge about the state of the art available. Gene has done his homework and has operated a number of harvesting heads before purchasing the LogMax. Both Gene and Paul have a wealth of knowledge they will share. This will be a working demonstration which will be interesting and informative.

The history of the acquisition and location of the forest lands involved is typical of what many of us are confronted with and it is important for us to learn how others are dealing with current forces in the market.

**WHO:** The WFFA members and any relatives, friends, neighbors, interested, likeminded, or forestry oriented folks are welcome.

**WHERE:** Heading north on Bond Road (Highway 307) heading toward Kingston, from Poulsbo you will travel through 3 stop lights. You will pass the Albertson Store at the third stop light, continue one mile to Parcell Road. Get in the left turn lane and turn left on Parcell. Go one mile and the logging operation and parking will be on the left. If you have a hardhat, bring it along.
