**WHEN:** Thursday, September 16, 2010, 6:00 P.M.

**WHAT/WHERE:** Stewart Family Tree Farm, Lebam, Washington

**This 20 year old stand has had many challenges. This provides you with a learning opportunity without the pain and costs! A large mountain beaver population was addressed before planting. Heavy competition from brush species was treated with an aerial application of 2-4-D. Severe damage from black bears is the latest challenge.**

**In 2009 a Family Forest Fish Passage project, coordinated by the Pacific County Conservation District and DNR, replaced a problem culvert to improve miles of salmon habitat. Learn more about the process and examine the finished product.**

**Please join us at Lebam. Look around, ask questions, and learn.**

**DIRECTIONS:** From the west: Take Hwy 6, just before Lebam, take a left on Lebam Road. At old Lebam school take a left, crossing the old RR grade onto Robertson Road, pass cemetery on your left, follow Robertson Road to its fork w/Cosset Lane – stay right on Robertson Road. Road will narrow, cross under power lines, through gate – follow signs to parking area.

**From east: on Hwy 6 pass through Lebam, take a right at the new post office. At old Lebam school take a right, crossing old RR grade onto Robertson Road, continue as above.**
