20 Acre Exemption Regulations and More

When: Wednesday, April 12th, 2006. Meeting starts at 7 PM

Who: Rick Kuykendall, Small Forest Landowner Specialist from the Department of Natural Resources (360-767-7002). Mike Nystrom from the DNR Stewardship office will also be available to help with questions if needed.

What: Rick will explain the 20-acre exemption rules & how they differ. He will also talk about some of the standard rules that still apply; water protection; Moratorium & County requirements, if any; your options on what “Class” permit you need vs. what site class your land is; leave tree rules; and whatever other general questions you have on the Forest Practice regulations.

WHERE: Thurston County Courthouse, Bldg 1, Room #280, 2000 Lakeridge Drive SW, Olympia, WA (From I-5 take exit #104 {Highway 101}, exit S.R. 101 at “Cooper Point/Auto Mall”, follow signs to Courthouse by turning right on Evergreen Park Drive, turn left on Lakeridge Dr., turn right into Court House Parking. Follow driveway to building #1 on the left side of the complex.)
