Everything you want to know about Surveys

WHEN: Wednesday, Feb 11th, 2009. Business Meeting/"Show and Tell"? @ 7PM; Program @ 7:30PM.

WHO: Kevin Bluhm of Bluhm and Associates located in Chehalis & Kalama. They have been doing surveys throughout southwest Washington for many years, including Thurston and Mason Counties.

WHAT: Kevin will give us an overview of forest surveying and discuss the many changes that have occurred over the years, particularly the new survey equipment/capabilities now available. It's hoped that you will bring your survey questions so he can at least point you in the right direction.

WHERE: New location - Room 172 in Natural Resources Building located at 1111 Washington Street SE Olympia, Washington. If Southbound: Take I-5 exit 105A, follow the "State Capitol" lane which parallels the freeway for 1/4 mile, or If Northbound: Take I-5 exit 105, keep to the left, following the "State Capitol" lane.

At the second traffic light (Capitol Way, the first light after the tunnel), turn right. Turn right again at the next traffic light (11th Ave.). At the next traffic light (Washington St.), turn right once more. Make the first left into the parking lot of the Natural Resources Building. If the doors from the parking lot are closed, enter the Building by walking around west side of building to 1st floor entrance.
