**To Hama Hama Tree Farm and Seafood Company from Interstate 5 in Olympia:**

Take I-5 to Exit 104 onto US HWY 101 N toward Aberdeen/ Port Angeles. After a few miles, HWY 101 exits to the right toward Shelton and Port Angeles. Stay on HWY 101 until you reach the Hama Hama Seafood retail store on the water side of the highway (reference milepost 320) at 35846 N US HWY 101.

Total distance from the I-5/HWY 101 exit – about 46.4 miles  
Travel time – about 58 minutes

**To get from Hama Hama to the Alderbrook Resort and Spa:**

Go south on HWY 101 about 16.7 miles, past Lilliwaup, Hoodport, and Potlatch. Take the left turn onto HWY 106. Follow HWY 106 through the Skokomish Indian land and then along Hood Canal. After traveling on HWY 106 for about 7 miles, the Alderbrook Resort and Spa will be on the left (water side) of the road.

Total distance – about 23.8 miles  
Travel time – about 37 minutes

**To get to Alderbrook from I-5 in Olympia:**

Take I-5 to Exit 104 onto US HWY 101 N toward Aberdeen/ Port Angeles. After a few miles, HWY 101 exits to the right toward Shelton and Port Angeles. Stay on HWY 101 until you reach the East Purdy Cutoff Road (about 27.2 miles from the I-5 turn off). Turn right on the East Purdy Cutoff Road. Go about 2.8 miles and turn right on HWY 106. Go a little over 5 miles and the Alderbrook Resort and Spa will be on the left (water side) of the road.

Total distance from the I-5/HWY 101 exit – about 35 miles  
Travel time – about 43 minutes
