

**WEFER'S FOREST LIMITED PARTNERSHIP  
POLICY #3.0/2015  
PARTNER TREE CUTTING POLICY**

**1. Purpose**

This policy establishes the reasons a partner may be allowed to cut trees for personal use, including historical use for docks, decks and pilings.

**2. Personal Use Definition**

"Personal Use" is defined as the cutting of unlimited hardwood (ex: maple, alder, birch, cherry, cottonwood, etc.) trees a year for the use of a partner either personally or by one of their family members. Family members can include family members of spouses.

**3. Softwood Trees Excluded**

Due to their market value, softwood (ex: fir, cedar, hemlock, etc.) trees are specifically excluded from this policy and will not be personally cut by partners unless agreement is obtained from the General Partner Representative **and** the President of Wefer Tree Farm, Inc.

**4. Revenue from Cut Trees**

Any and all revenue received by a partner from trees cut by a partner or partners under this policy will be given to the General Partner Representative for deposit into the Partnership's savings account.

**5. Harvesting & Transport Costs**

All harvesting, transport and other costs associated with a partner or partners cutting trees under this policy will be borne by the partner(s) cutting the trees.
