**CARE AND PLANTING INSTRUCTIONS:**

- Plant as soon as possible.
- Keep bare root seedlings in a cool, shady place. **Do Not Let Roots Dry.**
- Dig a hole 1' deep, spreading the roots as you fill your hole to just above collar with soil. **Do not let roots turn up like a "J."**
- Firm soil around the roots to remove air pockets. Keep weed/grass free 2-3 yrs. No need to fertilize the first year.
