### Services Provided by Regulatory Assistance

**Regulation Assistance Foresters:** Help for small forest landowners to understand and apply Forest Practice Rules and Board Manual Guidance.

More than just knowledge based solutions; Regulation Assistance provides information that will equip small Forest Landowners to complete a Forest Practice Application (FPA), including:

- Standard or Complex Forest Practice Rule questions
- Long term applications
- Alternate Plans
- 20 acre exempt harvest activities
- Harvest regime options

- Management strategies/Forest Practices activities
- Water/Wetland typing questions; RMZ/WMZ issues
- Riparian Management Zone (RMZ) and Wetland Management Zone (WMZ) options

### The role of the Regulation Assistance Fish & Wildlife

#### Biologist:

- ❖ Provides technical assistance for riparian and wetland areas
- ❖ Water type modifications on site & assistance with forms
- ❖ Conduct permitted electro-fishing, when appropriate, to determine fish presence
- ❖ Conduct stream surveys & fish barrier assessments
- ❖ Provide presentations and coordination with small forest landowner groups
